BEACH RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Access to the Beaches shall be by valid Beach Access Recreation Photo ID, Recreation Punch Card or daily Beach Pass for each individual, unless otherwise specified and/or approved by the District. Trespassing is prohibited at all times.
2. Vehicle parking is allowed in designated areas only. All vehicles in violation of parking restrictions shall be subject to towing at the owners expense. No reserving of parking spaces is allowed.
3. Glass containers of any kind are prohibited within the beach properties at all times.
4. Pets are prohibited on Incline Beach or Burnt Cedar Beach properties at all times. Dogs are allowed only on Ski Beach between mid-October and mid-April.
5. Loud playing of radios or other electronic equipment is prohibited. Amplified sound devices may not be used unless prior written permission is given by the District.
6. All beach gates will be closed at 10:00 P.M. daily.
7. Riding of mopeds, bicycles, and similar equipment is prohibited on all unpaved park pathways and turf areas.
8. Riding of skateboards is prohibited on the beach properties. Rollerblades are permitted to get users from the parking lots to the outside of the parks and vice versa. Other than stated, rollerblading within the parks is prohibited.
9. Nude sunbathing is prohibited on all District owned beaches at all times.
10. Fireworks of any nature are prohibited on the District owned beach properties unless authorized by the District in advance.
11. Swimming is allowed in the designated swim areas only.
12. All watercraft other than non-motorized inflatable rafts or inflatable kayaks are prohibited in the designated swim areas. Hard shell watercraft are not allowed in the swim areas. Motorized water craft must maintain a minimum distance of 200 feet from designated swim areas.
13. Any cooking of foods shall be in the permanent District supplied BBQ units and/or authorized privately owned gas BBQ appliances. Use of privately owned charcoal BBQ units are prohibited unless prior written permission is given by the District. Caterers on the District's preapproved list must obtain permission before event for any non gas BBQ appliances.
14. The vehicle speed limit in all District owned parks shall be 5 m.p.h. at all times.

15. Storing of gasoline within the District owned beaches shall be prohibited at any time unless authorized by the District.
16. Any diving or jumping off rocks or the boat ramp is prohibited at all times.
17. All loud, abusive and/or obscene behavior shall be prohibited at all times.
18. All open fires shall be strictly prohibited.
19. Children, 10 years of age and under, must be supervised by parents or guardians at all times.
20. Any use of the boat launching ramp or beaches for commercial purposes, unless authorized by the District, is prohibited.
21. Group use of the District-owned beaches is by facility use permit only. Groups of 20 people or more must submit an application to the Parks & Recreation Department at least seven (7) days prior to the event. Group use is limited to eligible Residents and their guests only. Reservations may be made for designated group picnic areas. They may be reserved by submitting a rental agreement and paying the rental fee.
22. The kayak / storage racks located on Ski Beach and Hermit Beach are for reserved long term rentals only. Any boats incorrectly stored on beach property will be taken to an off site storage area and fees will be charged.
23. Weddings on the District-owned properties are by permit only. An application for this use of the properties is mandatory and must be submitted to the District's Parks & Recreation Department at least seven (7) days prior to the event. Weddings are limited to eligible IVGID Beach Access Pass-holders and their guests only. No set-up is allowed.
24. All federal, state and county laws or regulations shall be strictly enforced.
25. It is the District's policy to prohibit illegal drinking and/or the possession or use of illegal drugs.
26. The District, or its representatives, shall have the right to refuse access to any individual or group. The District also reserves the right to remove individuals from the beaches should these rules or regulations be violated in any way. The District and its agents shall also have the authority to revoke recreation privileges in accordance with rules established by the District in Ordinance No. 7 (Recreation Pass Policy).
27. Zero Tolerance Policy adopted April 2004 - Abusive behavior of staff or other customers will not be tolerated. All District rules must be adhered to. Recreation privileges MAY be suspended for any period deemed appropriate or privileges may be revoked at District's sole discretion.

WATERCRAFT LAUNCHING RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Any vehicle with a watercraft entering the Ski Beach facility must have a valid season launching pass or the user must present a valid daily launching pass at the time of entry, or be eligible to purchase such at the Ski Beach gate.
2. Access to the boat ramp shall be by valid Recreation Photo ID, Recreation Punch Card or daily beach pass for each individual, unless otherwise specified and/or approved by the District. All boat riders must gain access by one of the above methods.
3. Boat registration must be on the vehicle at all times and must be presented to District staff or its contractor for verification if requested when using District-owned facilities.
4. The vehicular traffic areas within Ski Beach (watercraft launching facility) are designated loading zones for watercraft launching and retrieval only. Any parking of vehicles and/or trailers in these areas is strictly prohibited at all times.
5. The east side of the boat ramp is reserved for personal non-motorized watercraft (kayaks, canoes, small sailboats etc...).
6. The District may close the boat ramp to launching at its discretion without notice.
7. A 5 mph speed limit exists inside of the larger white buoys and within 200 feet of designated swim areas.
8. All powered watercraft must stay 100 feet from any person in the water.
9. Overnight mooring is prohibited.
10. All beach gates will be closed at 10:00 P.M. daily.
11. Pets are not allowed on beach properties except at Ski Beach October 15th – April 15th. As prescribed in the general Beach Rules and Regulations, pets may be transferred from car to boat only when launching and leaving the beach area. Swimming or wading is not allowed within the boat or personal watercraft use area.
12. All watercraft muffler systems must be in compliance with state and federal noise level standards.
13. All watercraft must be operated in a safe and courteous manner at all times.
14. Storing of flammables is prohibited on the District-owned beach properties. No refueling shall take place on the property.
15. The vehicle speed limit is 5 mph within the park.
16. All watercraft are subject to inspection and must follow current TRPA inspection regulations.
17. Any use of the boat launching ramp or beaches for commercial purposes, unless authorized by the District, is prohibited.

18. It is not advisable to use the boat-launching ramp when high wind conditions exist on the lake. Use under any conditions is at the risk of the participant.
19. The District reserves the right to remove individuals from the beaches and boat launching facility should these rules or regulations be violated in any way. The District and its agents shall also have the authority to revoke recreation privileges in accordance with rules established by the District in Ordinance No. 7 (Recreation Pass Policy).

CATERING EVENTS AT THE DISTRICT'S BEACHES

1. All Caterers must be on the District's preapproved Caterers list.
2. Caterers must follow all IVGID Beach use rules and regulations.
3. All catering staff requiring Beach access must either provide a valid Beach Access IVGID Recreation Photo ID (IVGID Pass-holder), other valid beach entry or be a paid guest of a valid beach access pass-holder.
4. Electricity and water requirements must be approved at least 7 days in advance.
5. No reserved parking spaces are allowed.
